
Prez Sez...


RENEW YOUR MEMBERSHIP

When you got the boogie in ya, it's got to come out!

This is a happy expression that applies to dancing, singing, and enjoying live or recorded music. It occurred to me that the notion also applies to riding!

"When you got the riding in ya, it's got to come out."

Yes, riding gives us some the same sensations and pleasures as dancing, singing, listening to music or playing an instrument. These things are popular sources of "boogie." Those of us who have been so fortunate to have discovered the wonderful



experience of riding can feel a similar sensation of "boogie." Take the "groove," for example. The groove of a beautiful ride, with scenery and curves and the company of friends, can be compared to the groove of dancing or playing in a band. How about the concentration? It is mesmerizing to focus intimately on a favorite song—or a favorite ride. In both cases, deep focus improves concentration on the activity at hand, be it dancing, singing, playing drums or any instrument, and of course, riding. What about rhythm? Rhythm is perhaps the gold standard of the boogie—just as it is with riding! The rhythm of the ride is that wondrous sensation that is part and parcel of the joy of riding. The big over-arching part of the boogie, be it on a dance floor or in the saddle of your bike, is, of course, happiness. Happiness is the priceless reward of the boogie, and nothing produces a deeper source of happiness than a fine motorcycle ride.

The boogie can occur anywhere. Traditionally dance floors or other music venues are the most popular locations. But when we ride, we let our boogie, or groove, and our boogie companions determine where and how we go. Our chosen route, our pace, our breaks or lack of breaks are all part of motorcycle boogie. So, music, dancing or riding all provide the wonder and the magic of the boogie. And with all forms of boogie, when it is in you, it has to come out!


BENBOW / FERNDALE / AVENUE OF THE GIANTS SATURDAY, MARCH 27 – SUNDAY, MARCH 28, 2021
