





HOT SILENT AUCTION ITEM

Titan Motorcycle Lift Table



This lift table was purchased new in 2017 and used twice.

I trimmed about ½ inch off both sides of the front stop, photo #1, and drilled 4 holes in the floor, photo #2, to mount a different front tire lock that didn't work as good as the original.

They cost about \$549 new.

The lift weights almost 300 lbs. I will deliver it on my trailer as long as it is within 35 miles of Petaluma. We can roll it out of the trailer.
